ARCHION Corporation (Headquarters: Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo; President & Chief Executive Officer: Karl Deppen; hereinafter “ARCHION”) has decided to join Commercial Japan Partnership Technologies Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo; President: Hiroki Nakajima; hereinafter “CJPT”) as well as Commercial Japan Partnership Technologies Asia Co., Ltd. (Headquarters: Thailand; President: Hiroki Nakajima; hereinafter “CJPT-Asia”).

ARCHION’s participation in CJPT-Asia follows the management integration of Hino Motors, Ltd.
